Personal Comfort Items - GPF 1312

Provides clothing, toiletries and personal comfort items for indigent and inpatient Veterans in need.

Veterans Holiday Fund - GPF 1325

Provides holiday and special occasion events, services and gifts for our inpatient Veterans.

Social Work Emergency Fund - GPF 1304

Provides indigent Veterans with food, transportation, and stays in local shelters.

Homeless Veterans Assistance - GPF 1315

Provides funding FOR supplies and services for HOMELESS Veterans.

Oncology Patient Fund- GPF 1318

Provides funding for Cancer patient's welfare and quality of life, to include comfort items, snacks, etc.
